



Your Step-by-Step Roadmap to Planning a Smart Remodel

1. Establish Your Total Budget Range

Start with a realistic number — this sets the tone for every design and construction decision.

Typical Remodeling Ranges:

• Kitchen Remodel: \$25,000-\$90,000+

• Bathroom Remodel: \$15,000-\$50,000+

Pro Tip: Expect to invest 10–15% of your home's value for a kitchen remodel and 5–10% for a bathroom remodel to maintain resale balance.

2. Understand Where the Money Goes

Kitchen Breakdown (Typical Percentages)

Category	% of Total	Description
Cabinets & Hardware	25–35%	Biggest visual impact; custom adds cost
Appliances	10–20%	Energy-efficient and built-in styles cost more
Countertops	10–15%	Quartz, granite, or solid surface
Flooring	5–10%	Tile, LVP, or hardwood
Plumbing & Fixtures	5–10%	Sinks, faucets, and water lines
Lighting & Electrical	5–10%	Recessed, under-cabinet, and pendants
Labor & Installation	25–35%	Licensed contractors and skilled trades
Contingency	10–15%	Always plan for surprises

Bathroom Breakdown (Typical Percentages)

Category	% of Total	Description
Fixtures (Toilet, Tub, Sink, Vanit	y)20–30%	Choose midrange for style + reliability
Tile & Flooring	10–20%	Materials and waterproofing add up
Plumbing & Electrical	15–20%	Especially if relocating fixtures
Lighting & Mirrors	5–10%	Function meets ambiance
Cabinetry & Countertops	10–15%	Vanity + storage upgrades
Labor & Installation	30–40%	Licensed work for code compliance
Contingency	10–15%	Always reserve for unknowns

3. Define Your Priorities

Before spending, clarify what matters most:



- Do you cook often and need premium appliances?
- Is a spa-like shower a must-have?
- · Would semi-custom cabinetry deliver enough customization?

4. Plan for Hidden or "Soft" Costs

Homeowners often forget:

Design fees: 3–10% of total project
Permits & inspections: \$500–\$3,000
Temporary living or dining needs

Upgrades to plumbing or electrical systems

5. The Value Factor

Midrange Kitchen Remodel: 60-70% ROI

Bathroom Remodel: 55-65% ROI

Well-designed remodels increase property value and daily enjoyment — a win-win for homeowners.

6. Sample Budget Templates

Kitchen Example (Total Budget \$60,000)

Cabinets: \$18,000 Appliances: \$9,000 Countertops: \$6,000 Flooring: \$4,000

Plumbing & Fixtures: \$4,500 Electrical/Lighting: \$3,500

Labor: \$10,000 Contingency: \$5,000

Bathroom Example (Total Budget \$25,000)

Fixtures & Vanity: \$5,000 Tile & Flooring: \$4,000 Plumbing & Electrical: \$4,500 Lighting & Mirrors: \$1,500

Labor: \$7,500 Contingency: \$2,500
